Pakistan in the news

Pakistan is often in the news
— and often for all the wrong
reasons. As the population has
now risen above 250 million,
two statistics stand out.

Poverty

The World Bank reports that 45% of Pakistan's population live below the poverty line. Related to their poverty is prejudice against Christians — equal in the law, but desperately unequal in society.

• Education

UNICEF reports that 22 million Pakistani children are out of school. According to UNESCO, the global poverty rate would be cut by more than half if all adults completed secondary education.

Anser and Kashi are a family unit, with two adult children, Dua (23) and Amn (19). Originally from Karachi, they moved to Lahore in 2012 to lead the work of Starfish Pakistan for the next 9 years. Anser and Kashi each hold M.Phil degrees in Education. They have 24 years of invaluable experience committed to the economic and spiritual welfare of underprivileged Christians.

Education, Training and Practice

chasing dreams in action



This pillar underscores our commitment to chase dreams through learning — empowering teachers to inspire their students

In 2023 we launched the 3Es Discipleship Programme, our commitment to Empower Early Educators, working with Christian schools across Pakistan to witness real change. We initially chose 6 schools that showed ambition but lacked training, direction and support.

We focus on improving the quality of education in Christian schools. This means regular training with monitoring to ensure our educators are well-prepared to inspire and guide. We also understand that hunger is a barrier to learning, so we aim to provide simple meals, allowing Christian students to access education without the burden of poverty. We aim to give small scholarships that will lead to income earning.

We're not just building schools; we're building futures by providing inspiration, incentives, essential books and educational resources to underprivileged children.

In 2026 we aim to increase our commitment to 10 schools and to ensure guaranteed outcomes.

Our monthly budget for each school: £500 (only possible with your generous support)



The EROS Model School

What does it take to see a dream come true? It takes a lot of hard work and leadership with vision and commitment.



We have been working with EROS School (Educational Reforms of Society) over the past many months. We have come to value the dedication of its Principal and staff. It is a school of 170 students with classes from Primary to 8.

Our 3-year agreement aims to empower the school towards self-sustainability through community ownership and support through parental contributions.

Our aim? A model for other Christian schools to admire, learn from and follow.

Faith and Biblical Understanding



The Amazing Story of Pakistan's Christians

At Chopan's National Career Festival, arranged in May 2025 for 650 graduating students, everyone who attended received a free copy of the book.

We have given away 1,000 books, and we want to give many more. Every Pakistani Christian should be proud to know their history!

We believe that academic excellence must be combined with biblical knowledge and faith. "Bible study for every student" will give every Christian a strong foundation for their future.

According to our means we aim to provide sets of academic textbooks to 3,000 students. In 2025 we were only able to provide books for 500 students. We aim higher in 2026.

We also face requests from 90 schools in the Lahore area to provide Bible Curriculum books (Grades 1 to 7) for their students. So far we have given them to 35 schools. We are now working with the local Publisher, Nirali Kitaben, to promote their use in many more schools in the coming year.

A dedicated Chopan staff member regularly visits schools to promote biblical ministry, and we pray to expand this outreach with additional staff to serve other parts of the country. For the next two years (2025-2026), together with training for up to 90 schools, we aim to give a course in biblical understanding to up to 25,000 young Pakistanis.

By grounding our students in faith, we aim to cultivate not just knowledge, but character, values, and a strong moral compass. This spiritual foundation will strengthen the Church and Christian witness long into the future.



Every student needs textbooks for their studies. Many cannot afford either academic or Bible Curriculum books. 90 schools are asking us for Bible books.

A full set of textbooks costs about £6 One Bible Curriculum book costs £1.60

A one-day seminar training 30 teachers in how to teach the Bible costs about £500.



Restoring Ambition & Dignity

Poverty and prejudice erode ambition and dignity.
We want to open doors of hope and ambition for young people in despair.

Scholarships and awards

We offer small scholarships, not to the high achievers, but to neglected boys and girls who score lower marks in national exams and have lost hope for their future. We aim to offer opportunities to pursue skilful diplomas such as Midwifery, Lady Health Worker, Lab Technician, Diploma of Associate Engineering in Computer Sciences, and other vocational fields – to pursue their dreams, regardless of academic talent.

Beyond financial aid, our counseling services provide crucial emotional and psychological support. It's about empowering them to see their potential and pursue it with confidence.

National Career Centre

In light of the recent National Career Festival, we now aim to set up a National Career Centre for High School graduates to get vital career advice. We now aspire to extend this to five other major cities in Pakistan. We plan other events: Speech and Writing Competitions, all to inspire hope and ambition.

The National Career Festival cost approximately £3,000, invested in the lives of tomorrow's leaders.

Now funds are needed to take it further: £1,000 would cover the costs of most such events.



The National Career Festival

After students graduate from High School, they face a confusing world of choice. Many feel they have no hope of a rewarding career in Pakistan's current climate.



In April 2025 we brought together 650 graduating students to listen to a panel of 20 qualified Christian professionals who shared their experience, informed and inspired them to greater ambition for their future.

Practical help for the needy



Chopan Trust is providing practical help for a hurting community, demonstrating the transformative power of direct aid.

Many of Pakistan's Christians face a bleak future, as the economy shrinks, inflation bites and poverty threatens millions.

In line with Chopan's Compassion Care we receive frequent requests for help for housing, medical needs and food. We would love to launch a regular food programme for the poorest Christian families.

16th December 2024: A Day of Celebration

1000 children from low-income Christian schools celebrated Christmas in Lahore's Renewal Centre. A further 200 celebrated at their homes on brick kilns. This was the Chopan Trust gift to 1200 children from poor homes — a meal, a celebration of the birth of Jesus, and the gift of a warm sweater to keep the cold of winter away.

Kamran, a painter on daily wages, his wife Kiran and their two children, lived in this condition for 17 Years.

The Meal Project

A local business man came to know the passion of the Chopan Trust. As director of a factory producing Indomie Instant Noodles, he was able to give us 5,000 packets of noodles for the children of several Christian schools.
